Well done to our Key Stage Two team who finished in 5th place out of 15 teams in the Camden School Sports Association Indoor Athletics Competition.

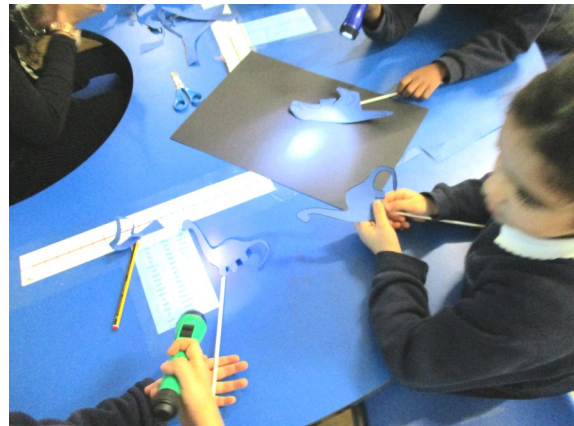
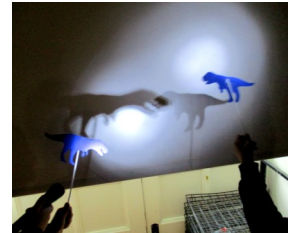
