Last week Year 3 visited the Natural History Museum. They visited the Volcanoes and Earthquakes exhibition which had lots of exciting things in it including volcanic rocks and a heat



suit that could withstand temperatures of 1000 degrees Celsius. There was even an earthquake simulator where the children could experience what it feels



like to be in a real earthquake! In the afternoon, the children attended an interactive show where they got to use a seismometer, create a miniature earthquake and watch a model volcano erupt. It was an exciting trip that has provoked lots of new

questions to investigate in our Topic lessons.
