We had a wonderful celebration of books and reading on World Book Day. Children in KS2 classes buddied


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up with children in KS1 and Early Years classes to read and work together on different book activities.

Year 6 enjoyed a workshop with Esther, who is a chemical scientist, from the wonderful Crick Institute. After impressing Esther with their knowledge of how light travels, there was a



demonstration of a laser beam travelling through water.



Using a splitter, Esther showed the class how a light beam can appear on two perpendicular surfaces at once.

In groups, the class explored using

a laser beam, mirrors and a splitter to shine the beam onto targets on a board.

On Tuesday, 3 Rowan and 3 Hazel visited the Natural History museum



to find out more about their new topic, 'On Dangerous Ground'. They really enjoyed seeing the Earth Hall as well as the exhibits about volcanoes, earthquakes and tsunamis. Year 3 also got to take part in an exciting workshop where they learned all about tectonic plates, used seismometers and even exploded a volcano.
