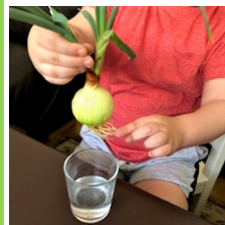

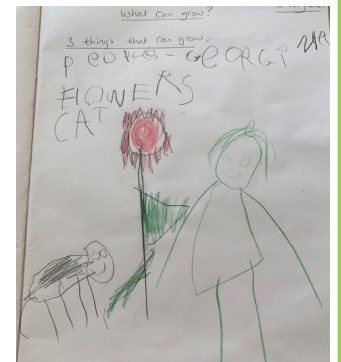
## Nursery – Learning and growing
