Lots of our families celebrated Eid al-Fitr this week. The children have been very excited all week in anticipation of their special celebration.

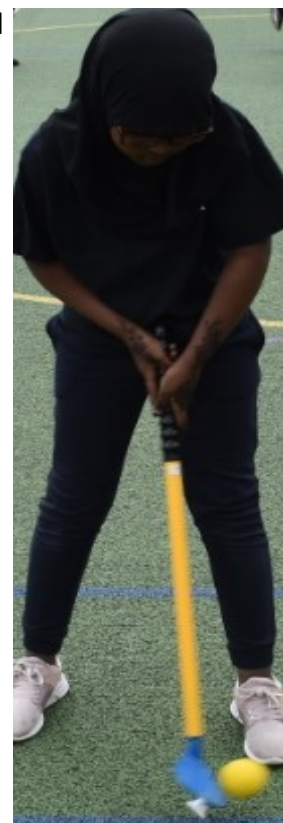
Today, parties were in full swing across the school with lots of lovely treats, games and fun.
