


Year 4: Rise of the Robots

Year 1: Dinosaur!

Year 1 have begun their new topic by discovering dinosaurs frozen in ice. They worked carefully together to excavate them using warm water and salt. They studied some real and replica fossils, including a mosasaur's jaw and some huge teeth.



In ICT, they used an augmented reality app to spot dinosaurs in the playground and the classroom. This has led to some very exciting writing.
